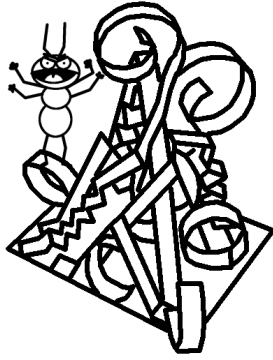


ARTY ANT PLAYGROUND

2. Save this instruction rectangle. It will be the base of your playground.
3. Bend, fold, and curl the strips of paper into imaginative shapes to make playground equipment for ant-sized people.
4. Flip this instruction rectangle over and glue the paper strips to it.
5. Look at your playground from all different angles. Does it look fun and interesting?
