
## **ZOOM-ZOOM SPINNER**



You'll need: This pattern (printed on cardstock paper), scissors, paper punch, glue stick, markers, 36" piece of string. \*A heavier string, like baker's string, works the best.

\*You'll need all four circles to make this toy. They will be stacked and glued together to make one heavy cardboard circle. You will need to punch two holes in each circle before you stack and glue them.

- 1. Color 2 of the circles.
- 2. Cut out all 4 circles.
- 3. Use a paper punch to punch two holes in each circle.
- 4. Stack all four circles together with the colored circles on top and bottom; facing out. Make sure the holes are lined up.
- 5. Glue them together to make a thick circle.
- 6. Thread a piece of string through the top of one hole and through the bottom of the other hole. Tie the ends of the string to make a large loop.
- 7. Slide the circle to the middle and grab the loop from each end. Rotate your hands toward you to spin the circle and twist the string. (Spin it toward you about 15 times to twist the string a lot.)
- 8. Pull the ends of the loop tightly then release slightly to see your circle spin. Keep pulling and releasing and it will continue to spin.
