SNOWFLAKE SYMMETRY CRAFT

You'll need: Scissors, and a glue stick

- 1. Cut out the small and large hexagon and the 6 long paper strips on the thick dark lines.
- Draw a glue line on one line segment of the large hexagon (from the center dot to the corner) and place a long
 paper strip (dark cutting lines down) on the glue. The paper strip will go from the center dot to beyond the edge
 of the hexagon. Repeat with the other 5 paper strips.
- 3. Glue the small hexagon. (Put glue on the side with the cutting lines.) And place it in the center of the large hexagon. This is the basic shape of the snowflake.
- 4. Cut out the shapes on the bottom of the page or create your own shapes. (You'll need six of each shape.)
- 5. Use the shapes to make a design one "arm" of the snowflake. (Remember to flip them over so the dark lines are on the back.) Glue the shapes in place. Repeat the pattern on each "arm" of the snowflake.
