U.S.A. PINWHEEL

You'll need: A new pencil with eraser, long sewing pin, tape, crayons or markers, scissors, (hot glue gun)

- 1. Color the pinwheel square, stars, and paper strips, and cut them out.
- 2. Cut each angled line on the pinwheel square.
- 3. Push a straight pin through each numbered dot. Thread the pin through the back of each hole you made in number order curve dot 1 behind dot 2, 2 behind 3, and 3 behind 4. Then push the pin through the center dot (5). Finally, push the pin through the pencil eraser. (To make sure the pin can't be removed, push it through the eraser so about 1/16" goes out the back side of the eraser. Then use a hot glue gun to cover the tip of the pin with a bead of glue. Let it dry.)
- 4. Glue a star to the end of each strip.
- 5. Place the bottom end of the strips on the pencil. Wrap a piece of tape around them.

*Hold your pinwheel and blow on it or spin in circles. You'll hear the clack, clack, clack of the little stars hitting the pinwheel.
